

Throughout our history, Barbosa Cabinets, Inc. has been committed to producing fine cabinetry. These cabinets are guaranteed against defects in material and/or workmanship for a period of one year from the date of occupancy or close of escrow, whichever occurs first. This warranty applies only to the original homeowner and is not transferrable to subsequent occupants.

Adjustments that are required at a later date due to normal wear, settling and/or drying out of the house, are not considered defects and therefore are not covered under this warranty. Such adjustments include, but are not limited, to doors, drawers and interior storage systems.

This warranty does not extend to painted cabinets as Barbosa Cabinets, Inc. does not have control over the quality of the paint, and the qualification of the painter and the application of paint.

This warranty does not extend to difference in natural color or grain patterns in wood. Nature never creates two pieces of wood that are exactly alike, even from the same tree. Due to this difference in natural color and grain, each piece of wood will react differently to the finishing materials. Materials, knots, and slight surface cracks are not covered by this warranty, as they are true characteristics of quality solid and veneer wood products. These naturally occurring characteristics, as found in all wood products, are acceptable when within our product standards and commercial tolerance. Natural woods, thermo foil and laminate products exhibit subtle changes in color as they age and are not considered product defects. Variations also occur in hand wiped glazes and these variations in finishes should not be considered defects in workmanship or material but are what gives each piece a unique and authentic, hand crafted look.

Barbosa Cabinets, Inc. will, at its own election and after careful inspection, repair, replace or make appropriate adjustments to true defects in material and/or workmanship occurring during normal usage within the one-year warranty period.

In keeping with our policy of continuous product refinement, we reserve the right to change specifications in design and materials, as conditions require.

Care And Cleaning For Your Cabinets After Warranty Expiration

After the warranty expires, it will be up to the homeowner to decide whether to use some form of furniture polish, wax or spray. It is not required to preserve the finish under normal conditions, and depending on the specific product, it may even be harmful and damaging to the sheen. Unless each successive coat of wax, oil, or polish is cleaned off prior to re-application, a dulling effect can take place. With proper care and cleaning your beautiful finish should last you for years to come.
